<u>Note</u>: Fidelity Power Systems recommends running your generator loaded each week for a minimum of 30 minutes to ensure dependability, circulate and filter fuel on diesel units, remove moisture from gas units, and test automatic transfer switches (ATS's). NFPA-110 requires a 30-minute loaded run once a month on all ATS's, at or above 30 % rated load for diesel engines, and with available load for gas units. (NFPA-110 chapter 8.4)
